WHITE WINES

1 Geno Branco 2020, Alentejo, Portugal 13% 125ml £5.50 250ml £9.75 £24

A light, fresh and vibrant blend of indigenous grape varieties loaded with white peach and crispy acidity.

2 Picpoul de Pinet Blanc 2021, Jean Luc Colombo, France 13% 125ml £6.50 250ml £11.75 £28

Freshness and roundness, with a great length. Minerality a crisp perfect with Seafood.

3 The Crossings, Sauvignon Blanc 2022, Awatere Valley, New Zealand 12.5% 125ml £7.00 250ml £12.75 £31

Pure fruit and bright fresh acidity that drives a complex and mineral finish.

4 Domaine de Grand Maison Muscadet de Sevre et Maine sur Lie, 2020 12.5% 125ml £7.00 250ml £12.75 £34

Delicate aromas of stone and citrus fruit and a palate of everything you would want from a Muscadet of this quality, fresh, fruity with a lasting finish.

5 Fertuna Vermentino 2019, Tuscany, Italy 12.5% £37

Vermentino from the heart of the Tuscan Maremma, standing out for its rich but delicate, aromatic style combined with a remarkable acidity.

6 Laurent Miquel Solas Reserve Albarino 2021, 13% £38

Aromas of tropical fruit, citrus and delicate floral mineral overtones. The Palate is refreshing with generous exotic fruit characters and a hint of lime on the finish.

7 Mâcon Villages 2017, Domaine Chanson, France 13% £40

Delicate floral fragrances on a mineral note. Well balanced and crisp. Good acidity and subtle minerality. Refreshing finish.

8 The Crossings, Pinot Gris 2022, Awatere Valley, New Zealand 13% £43

Concentrated notes of ripe pear, quince and honeysuckle, with underlying spicy aromas. The palate is luscious and generous showing wonderful balance between fruit and acidity with a long dry finish.

9 Chateau de Fontaine Audon 2021, Sancerre Cuvee Silex France 12.5% £53

Sauvignon from Loire Valley. Very expressive nose of ripe and exotic fruits. Great balance and nice acidity bringing freshness.

10 Ceretto Blangé Arneis 2018, Langhe, Italy 13% £53

Blangé is the white side of Piedmontese wines. Produced with Arneis, a grape variety from Roero region, this wine combines fruit and minerality, aromatics and balanced freshness.

11 Montagny 1er Cru 2018, Domaine Chanson, Burgundy, France 13% £64

Floral fragrances mixed with citrus fruit on a hint of minerality. Well structured, precise. Very pure fruit with a tight texture. Refreshing and slightly stony aftertaste.

12 Chablis Grand Cru, Valmur 2015, Domaine Chanson, Burgundy, France 13% £74

Floral fragrances mixed with aromas of citrus fruit mixed with pale fleshed fruit (pear). Iodine character. Well-balanced, concentrated and precise. Well-integrated minerality. Salty notes. Refreshing aftertaste with a saline finish.

13 Hamilton Russell Chardonnay 2021, Hemel-en-Aarde Valley, South Africa 13% £75

Pear and lime fruit aromas and flavours are brought beautifully into focus by a tight line of bright natural acid and a long, dry minerality.

14 Meursault 2019, Domaine Chanson, France 13.5% £89

Four different plots of vineyards are used from selected vigneron. Two are located on mid slope for finesse and minerality, the two others are situated around the village for more richness and depth.

15 Pernand Vergelesses Les Caradeux 2018, Domaine Chanson, Côte de Beaune, France 15% £105

From a well-situated plot, mid-slope, not far from Corton Charlemagne. This has excellent weight of soft white peachy fruit along with plenty of zesty citrus and mineral notes. Great length and an elegant finish.

16 Chassagne-Montrachet 2018, Domaine Chanson, France 13.5% £105

Floral fragrances mixed with citrus fruit aromas. Delicate vanilla note. Punchy and complex. Deep and tight texture. Long and focused finish.

17 Condrieu Invitare 2016, M. Chapoutier, France 13.5% £109

Deep golden yellow with a greenish tint. The palate is very well balanced, full, with a nice freshness which gives a great elegance to this wine.

19 Corton Vergennes Grand Cru 2011, Domaine Chanson, France 14% £209

Great white Burgundy coming from Corton hill. Complex, deep and voluminous. Beautiful fruit combination. Harmonious.

Well-integrated minerality with a delicate oak-note.

20 Corton Charlemagne Grand Cru 2012, Domaine Chanson, France 13.5% £220

The vineyards are located on the upper part of the hill of Corton. Well integrated acidity, subtle oak note with saline and well-balanced finish.

| 45 | Prodigal Grenache 2018, Kilikanoon, Clare Valley, Australia 14.5%
<i>One of the most representative wines made by Kilikanoon, the Prodigal continues to set the standard for Clare Valley old vine Grenache with its polished tannins and fine bodied acidity.</i> | | | £47 |
| 46 | Sela 2019, Bodegas Roda, Rioja, Spain 14%
<i>Intense red blend of Tempranillo, Graciano and Garnacha. Cherry red in colour, red fruits aromas and lively, fresh flavours on palate.</i> | | | £49 |
| 47 | Crozes Hermitage Les Fées Brune 2021, Jean-Luc Colombo 13%
<i>Beautiful cherry colour with hints of violet. Small fruits such as blackcurrant and blackberry, with notes of pepper on the nose. The palate is strong yet silky approach with supple tannins, and beautiful, long finish with hints of spices and violet.</i> | | | £50 |

<i>The selected Sangiovese grapes come from the Estate vineyards in southern hills of Montalcino. A super classic wine, warm and soft on the palate with great structure and round tannins.</i> | | | £51 |
| 50 | Klein Constantia Estate Red 2019, South Africa 14.5%
<i>Intense and deep blend, ruby red in colour with rich aromas of black fruit and elegant notes of sandalwood. The palate is full bodied and layered.</i> | | | £59 |
| 51 | Akitu A1 Pinot Noir, 2018, New Zealand 13.5%
<i>Dark garnet colour with a crimson edge in a deep plummy hue. Layers of graphite, brown spice and wild herbs sit across dark plummy fruit. Ripe dark cherries, dark rose petal and a hint of sous bios are all coiled very tightly in a compact bundle of aromatic intensity.</i> | | | £69 |
| 52 | Roda Reserva 2016, Rioja, Spain 14.5%
<i>The vineyards used to produce this blend are located near Haro, the historic heart of La Rioja Alta. Concentration of intense aromas of crushed red cherries and savoury herbs and ripe, spicy, structured fruit on the palate with soft tannins and a long finish.</i> | | | £74 |
| 53 | Turkey Flat Shiraz 2015, Barossa Valley, Australia 14.5%
<i>The Turkey Flat Vineyard boasts some of the oldest Shiraz vines in the world. Dark, spicy with generous fruit sweetness backed up by savoury, supple tannins.</i> | | | £80 |
| 54 | Chateauneuf du Pape Les Bartavelles 2019, Jean-Luc Colombo, France 14.5%
<i>Intense crimson-red from a terroir of pebbles from the old bed of the Rhone. Complex and subtle nose of blackcurrant and plum. On the palate it is delicate yet full-bodied with spicy finish.</i> | | | £82 |
| 55 | Brunello di Montalcino 2014, Ciacci Piccolomini d'Aragona, Italy 14.5%
<i>Prestigious Brunello produced by the historic Ciacci Piccolomini d'Aragona Winery. Ruby red in colour verging on garnet. Intense, spicy and floral with hints of red berry fruits enriched by delicate spicy notes. Warm, soft and very well balanced on the palate with soft tannins and long aftertaste.</i> | | | £96 |
